WHAT: what can be stored. Boat & its designated transport trailer, jet ski & designated transport trailer, utility trailers open or enclosed, landscape type trailer, camper trailer.

All no greater than 25'.

All trailers must be registered in the state of ownership & in working order.

Vote regarding commercial trailers permitted.

NOT For VOTE=

HOW: form & lot layout on computer. Fill out name, phone, address, item, vehicle registration tag, pic, vin #, MM tag. You will be designated an area based on sizes, etc by committee. Application forms must be submitted prior to trailer returns.

DISCLAIMER: Just a reminder that MM is NOT responsible for any damage or theft- you are parking at your own risk. Also MM may remove any item for non compliance at the owners expense.
